CORPUS CHRISTI—A FOCUS ON THE EUCHARIST

This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of Corpus Christi. It gives us an ideal opportunity to reflect on our relationship with the Eucharist. It is very easy, because the Eucharist is so familiar to us to take it for granted and indeed be complacent about it. According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church, the Eucharist is the source and summit of the Christian life. When we attend Mass be aware that it is the highest form of prayer.

Adoration

Preparation for the celebration of the Eucharist is important, and indeed spending time in Adoration is strongly encouraged and promoted. However Adoration should not take place during Mass, as the Lord is becoming present on the Altar. Again we are always looking for more Adorers in both churches and strongly encourage you to spend some time there.

Approaching for Holy Communion

As we approach the Eucharist is it important that we truly believe Jesus to be present, and therefore be properly prepared. If we receive Communion in the hands please make sure that your hands are clean, you are not holding any object, and not wearing gloves. Otherwise you might consider receiving Holy Communion on the tongue.

As we approach the altar, we do so as part of a procession, slowly and reverently, taking our time and not rushing. If you receive Holy Communion on the hand, please consume the Sacred Host before you leave the Communion station. On returning to your seat we encourage a time of quiet prayer and thanksgiving.

Communion to the sick and housebound

The priests of the Parish visit those who are sick and housebound on a monthly basis throughout the year. Should anyone like to be added to those lists please contact the Parish Office. Those who wish to receive Holv Communion more regularly at home often have Ministers calling to them. This can be arranged through the priests. It is essential that anyone taking Communion from the church in a pyx, inform one of the priests that they are doing so. It is important that Eucharistic Ministers who are assisting at Mass only have the Host placed in the pyx after Communion. Please ensure that if you are taking Communion to someone at home that you are free to do so, going straight to the person's home after Mass without running other errands first.

Being Ready

At the start of Mass the penitential rite prepares us to receive Holy Communion worthily, we also recommend and encourage regular Confessions.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK

The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick takes place at the 10:00am Mass next Saturday June 8th. While we are delighted to be able to offer this Sacrament to those who need it and eligible to receive it, we remind parishioners again that this is a sacrament of the Church, and not simply a blessing and only avail of it if you are in need of it. It is recommended that this Sacrament be received no more than once per month.
