REMEMBERING OUR BELOVED DECEASED

- the great Solemnity of All Saints or All Hallows on November 1st and
- the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed or All Souls on November 2nd.

The Annual Novena for the Deceased here in our parish runs from: **Saturday 2nd to Monday 11th November**. Altar Lists of the Deceased will be available which can be returned to both churches before or during the Novena. During Mass times there will be a box located in front of the altar. Otherwise leave them in the silver box at the side of the altar.

Novena Masses at 10am each day. Family intentions returning on November 12th.

NORMS FOR INDULGENCES AT THE COMMEMORATION OF ALL SOULS

1. From twelve o'clock noon on 1st November until midnight on 2nd November, all who have confessed, received Holy Communion and prayed for the pope's intentions (one Our Father and Hail Mary, or any other prayer of one's choice) can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a church or oratory, and there reciting one Our Father and the Apostle's Creed. This indulgence is applicable only to the souls of the departed. Confession may be made at any time within the week preceding or the week following the 1st of November. Holy Communion may be received on any day from 1st. November to 8th November.

2. The faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls on the usual conditions once per day from 1st to 8th November. The conditions mentioned above also apply for this.

PASTORAL COUNCIL MEETING OCTOBER

The Pastoral Council met last Tuesday night in the Pastoral Centre. (1) Early in the month the Chairperson, Secretary and President of the Pastoral Council attended a workshop in Galway run by the Diocese. All present felt it was very worthwhile. As follow-on to this, Niamh Morris, Diocesan Pastoral Resource Person, has been invited to attend the November meeting of the Pastoral Council. Part of this meeting will be to review the first year progress of the Council. (2) The 2025 parish calendar was reviewed at this meeting. Discussion took place on various events that could happen as part of Holy Year 2025. (3) We also looked at doing more around Seasons of Creation in September and October and also around the Rosary. We hope to have an event ceremony of Prayer for Peace on January 1st.
