NORMS FOR INDULGENCES AT THE COMMEMORATION OF ALL SOULS

1. From twelve o'clock noon on 1st November unti midnight on 2nd November, all who have confessed received Holy Communion and prayed for the pope's intentions (one Our Father and Hail Mary, or any other prayer of one's choice) can gain one plenary indulgence by Have you celebrated a significant wedding anniversary this applicable only to the souls of the departed.

Confession may be made any time within the week Communion may be received on any day from 1st - 8th Nov. **2.** The faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence applicable only to the Holy Souls on the usual conditions once per day from 1st - 8th November. Conditions mentioned above also apply for this.
