### MUSIC IN THE LITURGY DURING ADVENT

Since Advent has a penitential character (the Gloria is not said the priest wears violet vestments, the altar is not decorated with flowers), the Church asks that the music should reflect this character. You might notice that the organ is not played during Advent, unless necessary to support singing. The exception to this is the third Sunday of Advent ("Gaudete Sunday"), which has a more joyful tone, and the organ may be played. During the Sundays of Advent the choir sings a traditional antiphon in honour of Our Lady at the end of Mass Alma Redemptoris Mater. The translation is as follows:

Kind mother of the Redeemer, who remains the open gate o heaven and the star of the sea: help your falling people who want to rise. You who bore your holy Parent, while nature marvelled: a Virgin before and after, receiving that 'Ave' from Gabriel's mouth, have mercy on us sinners.
