From twelve o'clock noon on 1st November until midnight on 2nd November, all who have confessed, received Holy Communion & prayed for the pope's intentions (one Our Father & Hail Mary, or any other prayer of one's choice) can gain one plenary indulgence by visiting a church or oratory, & ther reciting one Our Father & the Apostle's Creed. This indulgence is applicable only to the souls of the departed. Confession may be made at any time within the week preceding or the week following the 1st of November. # ACN WEEK OF WITNESS / RED WEDNESDAY

Did you know, some 360 million Christians live in countries where they are persecuted for their faith? Each year the papal charity Aid to the Church in Need (ACN) Ireland — which supports some 6,000 communities in 140 countries highlights their plight during the 'Week of Witness' (Nov. 15th to 23rd). Red Wednesday (Nov. 19th) is the highlight of the week, and Catholics are urged to keep the suffering Church in their prayers in a special way. During this week, we are invited to remember and pray for our brothers and sisters around the world who suffer for their faith. We reflect on their courage, pray for their safety, and offer our solidarity through thought, word & deed. You can find out more on www.acnireland.org. ACN International was founded in 1947, in the aftermath of the devastation of World War II to support those who were displaced and suffering. Over the years the charity has grown and today it has national offices in 23 countries, with the Irish office being established in 1989.

The stipends from the provision of Mass Cards in our parish is passed on in total to the priest celebrating the Mass for the particular intention. One of the two charities we send the Mass stipends to is Aid to the Church in Need (ACN). These Masses are celebrated by priests who are supported by ACN. The other charity we send the stipends to are priests in Simanjiro with whom the parish has a partnership.
