Pope St. John Paul II began the tradition of Bambinelli Sunday which takes place this weekend. Figures of the Baby Jesus brought by people to Mass are blessed, reminding us of Christ's presence in our homes & hearts this Christmas. May this simple devotion inspire faith, hope, & love in every household.

THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT ("GAUDETE" SUNDAY)

During Advent it is worthwhile to reflect on how we can wait well. Advent is the perfect season for this, to slow down the pace, to focus on what really matters & embrace the joy of expectant hope. However on the Third Sunday of Advent ("Gaudete" or "Rejoice" Sunday), the liturgy takes on a more joyful character as a reminder that the birth of Christ is near. To reflect this, the organ, which is normally silent during Advent, may be played. We also see that the rose candle is lit on the Advent wreath, the priest may wear rose-coloured vestments (rather than the usual violet colour of Advent), & the sanctuary area may be decorated with flowers.
